

2010 SSAA TAS Combined Services State Championships

The Blue Hills Shooting Club has the pleasure of hosting this event on their range at Copping, South East of Sorell.

These events will be held on Saturday 18th & 19th of September 2010, with practice on Friday 17th.

If time permits, there may be a short practice session on Saturday morning, prior to competition.

SATURDAY RIFLE PROGRAMME

Event 1. will be 3P "Core" shoot at 100, 200 & 300 metres. 30 rounds required.

Event 2. will be Match 9 in the Combined service rifle book, 10 rounds deliberate, at 300 metres.

Event 3. will be Match 4, Rapid Fire B, at 100 metres, 20 rounds required.

Event 4. will be Match 6, SNAP "B", Shot at 100 metres 10 rounds required.

If time allows, there will be a non-championship tactical event at 500 metres. This event will be open to all comers, but rifles must be of a military calibre, as described on the SSAA web site.

Eligible Firearms

Rifle Classes are for categories A (Short rifle) & B (Long rifle) Shot as one class, and category "H", modified. Eligible firearms are listed on the SSAA web site

SUNDAY PISTOL PROGRAMME

Event 1. will be the 3P "Core" shoot, at 25m, 15m, and 7m. 36 rounds required.

Event 2. will be Match 2 in the pistol section of the combined services rule book. 3P deliberate, at 25m, 18 rounds required.

Event 3. will be Match 6. Standing rapid fire at 15m 6 rounds required.

Event 4. will be Match 4. Standing deliberate, at 15m 12 rounds required.

Eligible pistols are as described on the SSAA web site, and in the Combined Service rule book. Classes 1, 2 & 3 will shoot as one class.

TIMING

The range will be open for practice between 11 am & 4.00pm on Friday 17th.

Sign in on Friday will begin at 10.00 am

On Saturday, sign in and rifle scrutineering will begin at 8.00am, with briefing at 9.15am and competition will begin at 9.30am. Late entries will not be accepted.

Timings for the Sunday pistol event will be as for Saturday.

RANGE FEES AND ELEGIBILITY

These events are open to any SSAA member, and a current SSAA Card will need to be shown at sign in. Mainland visitors are welcome to compete, and will be eligible for medals.

For pistol events, an “H” category must be on your firearms licence, and will need to be sighted at sign in.

GRADING

Graded shooters will need to have with them their grading cards.

Ungraded shooters will be classified in grade on the scores shot in the 3P “Core” shoot.

If interest is shown a “grading shoot” may be possible during Friday practice.

RANGE FEES

Friday practice fee will be \$10 for all shooters. A flat fee of \$40 per day will be charged with Junior (shooters under the age of 18 years) paying \$20 per day for competition days.

State Medals will be supplied by SSAA Tas, and will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each grade, including juniors, for the “Core” shoots only, (Pistol & Rifle) other events will have medals for 1st 2nd & 3rd open all grades.

HOW TO GET THERE

First find Sorell. From Sorell, travel South East towards Port Arthur. Find the Carlton River, and then turn right into BLUE HILLS Road, at 1 Km past the Carlton River sign.

Sign says “PRIVATE ROAD NO ACCESS” Ignore this and follow the gravel road to the range. Range area will be well sign posted. WARNING! watch out for large trucks!
